

## ICD-9 to ICD-10 Crosswalk for the Chiropractic Office

### COMMONLY USED CODES:

ICD-9 Code	Description
739.1	Nonallopathic lesions of cervical region NEC
739.2	Nonallopathic lesions of thoracic region NEC
739.3	Nonallopathic lesions of lumbar region NEC
739.4	Nonallopathic lesions of sacral region NEC

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ICD-10 Code	Description
M99.01	Segmental and somatic dysfunction of cervical region
M99.02	Segmental and somatic dysfunction of thoracic region
M99.03	Segmental and somatic dysfunction of lumbar region
M99.04	Segmental and somatic dysfunction of sacral region

*In some cases, it is a simple conversion from one code to another (shown above). Of course the actual code changes, but so does the description with the goal being specificity. For a better showing of how ICD-10 may necessitate a change in documentation, see below:*

ICD-9 Code	Description
847.2	Lumbar sprain (includes joint capsule, ligament, muscle, tendon)
724.3	Sciatica - Neuralgia or neuritis of sciatic nerve
724.4	Thoracic or lumbosacral neuritis or radiculitis, unspecified

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ICD-10 Code	Description
S33.5XXS	Sprain of ligaments of lumbar spine, sequela
S33.5XXA	Sprain of ligaments of lumbar spine, initial encounter
S335XXD	Sprain of ligaments of lumbar spine, subsequent encounter
S338XXS	Sprain of other parts of lumbar spine, sequela
S33.8XXA	Sprain of other parts of lumbar spine, initial encounter
S33.8XXD	Sprain of other parts of lumbar spine, subsequent
M54.32	Sciatica, left side
M54.31	Sciatica, right side
<b>M54.42*</b>	Lumbago with sciatica, left side
<b>M54.41*</b>	Lumbago with sciatica, right side
M54.14	Radiculopathy, thoracic region
M54.15	Radiculopathy, thoracolumbar region
M54.16	Radiculopathy, lumbar region
M54.17	Radiculopathy, lumbosacral region
